Rules & Regulations to be fulfilled by the College/Institute

For

Diploma Course in Homoeopathic Pharmacy(DHP)

CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BY THE ACADEMIC TRAINING INSTITUTION

- A. Approval of the institution:- The course of regular sudy shall be conducted in an institution approved by the Homoeopathic Medicine Board. The Homoeopathic Medicine Board, U.P shall not approve any institution unless it provides adequate arrangements for teaching in regard to building, accommodation, equipment and teaching staff as specified.
- B. Accommodation:- Suitable and sufficient accommodation with adequate ventilation, lighting and other hygienic conditions should be provided to the rooms for principal, Head of the department, office, class room, library, auditorium/hall, staff common room, student common room, museum, stores, laboratory, Record room, toilets and separate drinking water facility etc. At least four laboratories specified below should be provided for:-
 - 1- Homoeopathic Pharmaceutics Lab
 - 2- Homoeopathic Pharmaceutical chemistry Lab.
 - 3- Physiology, Biochemistry, clinical pathology lab.
 - 4- Pharmacognosy, Hospital and clinical pharmacy lab.
 In addition to the laboratories balance room, aseptic room, animal house, machine room, anatomy museum should also be provided.
 Laboratory area should be sufficient to accommodate at least 25 students at a time.
 Laboratory should be so constructed that it can be kept clean. Gas, water fitting, shelves etc shall be provided wherever necessary.

The following staff is required for Homoeopathic Pharmacist Training Course:-

- 1- Professor/Reader(*may also work as principal-one or head of the department, as the case may be).
- 2- Senior Lecturers'/Lectures Eight

 The minimum qualifications for the above posts should be as given below:-
 - 1- Principal/Professor/Reader:
 - a. Essential qualifications:- A recognized diploma or degree in homoeopathy, not less than four years duration and five years teaching experience in homoeopathic pharmacy/homoeopathic compounders training course. .
 - b. Preferential qualification: Candidates having administrative /hospital /research experience in a recognized homeopathic institution will be given preference.
 - c. Age:- Not more than 45 years as on the last date of receipt of application for the post. Age relaxable in case of exceptionally qualified person.

- 2- Lecturer in Drug store and business management:-
 - B. Essential Qualification -Pharma with three years teaching /professional experience or M.Com with good academic record and three years of teaching experience or recognized diploma or degree in Homoeopathy, not less than four years duration with three years of teaching/professional experience.

3- Lecturer in other subjects:-

Essential Qualification -A recognized diploma or degree in homeopathy of not less than four years duration with three years of teaching/professional experience.

<u>Age for Lecturers</u>:- Not more than 35 years as on the last date of receipt of application for the post. Age relaxable in the case of an exceptionally qualified person.

- C. Museum: Every institution shall maintain museum of :-
 - 1- Anatomy _ Sufficient quantity of models and charts etc. shall be kept.
 - 2- Museum of drug materials:- It should contain herbarium sheets, botanical specimens of the drugs and plants coloured slide/photo of medicinal plant, mentioned in the course. In addition it is recommended that containers of common usage in medicines shall be kept with display of popular medicines. Besides this herbarium of at least 100 indian plants of medicinal use shall also be maintained

- D. <u>Library</u>:-Every institution shall maintain a library which should contain books according syllabus and also the current homoeopathic pharmaceutical journals. There should be adequate place in the library for students and staff, separately, to refer books. Facility to issue books will be provided to staff and students.
- E. <u>Hostel</u>:- Hostel with mess facility for male and female students separately shall be provided.

 Adequate space for outdoor and indoor games shall also be provided.
- F. <u>Canteen</u>:- Every institution shall provide a canteen for staff and students separately on no profit, no loss basis.

<u>Note</u>: The above requirements are the minimum requirements and the institute is free to provide more physical and teaching facility. The institution shall also make all necessary arrangements for conduct of the examinations.
